Registration Cancellation Policy

Cancellation received

- till **June 15, 2026** – full refund, 10 % handling fee will be deducted
- after **June 15, 2026** - 50% refund, 10 % handling fee will be deducted
- after **July 17, 2026** - no refund

Refunds will be made after the completion of the conference.

- For payments received by credit or debit cards, the same credit/debit card will be refunded.
- For all other payments, a bank transfer will be made to the payee's nominated account, and all bank charges will be for the registrant's account.
- If the conference cannot be held or is postponed due to situation(s) beyond the control of the conference organizers, the participant's contribution will be 100% refunded.

Venue:

Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic, is a historic city known for its stunning architecture, charming old town, and rich cultural heritage. Often called *the City of a Hundred Spires*, it blends medieval beauty with vibrant modern life. You can also enjoy cozy cafés, and breathtaking views along the Vltava River.

The RSE-SEE 10 will be held in the [Conference Center Krystal](#) located only four metro stations from the historic center of the city.

How to get to the venue:

The Conference Center Krystal is easily reachable by car or by public transportation from both the Prague airport and the city center.

How to reach the venue if you go by:

Public transport from the Prague airport:

At the stop TERMINAL 1 or TERMINAL 2 get on the trolleybus no. 59. Get off at the 7th stop **Nádraží Veleslavín** (approx. 17 minutes ride). As you get off the trolleybus and look westward, you will see the hotel Krystal straight in front of you. It is a seventeen-storey building, that cannot be overlooked. It is within a walking distance from the bus stop (approx. 550 m).

Public transport from the Prague city center (railway station, bus station):

Please, take the Metro, line A to the metro stop **Nádraží Veleslavín**. As you get off the metro follow the sign "ulice José Martího" (stairs) or sign "Airport" (escalator).
